Topper have a unique understanding of manufacturing in plastic built up over 25 years of producing the original Topper dinghy. The Omega optimises the special needs of the chosen moulding technique to new and unrivalled levels of sophistication, ensuring uniformity of wall thickness and the perfect strength to weight ratio.

Topper International's unparalleled expertise in this field has meant that the very latest rapid advances in material technology have been fully harnessed to produce a uniquely strong, lightweight, stiff and durable hull. The Omega hull is moulded with incredible precision and the Topaz-style technique produces a hull with far higher levels of structural uniformity and

consistency than any other sailboat of this type. The Trilam structural polyethylene construction ensures toughness without increasing hull weight with masses of built in buoyancy. The lightweight extra strength honeycomb core is surrounded by a hardseal inner skin and a really strong, high quality Metalicene outer skin.

This precision moulded TRILAM 3-ply sandwich polyethylene construction is unique to Topper and guarantees that no other manufacturer's roto-moulded sailboats come even close to the Omega in terms of strength, rigidity and durability. What you get is a beautiful curvaceous hull that performs like a dream, is virtually maintenance free, comes complete with an impressive three year warranty and, in the unlikely event of an accident, is easy to repair.

The dynamic yet forgiving Howlett hull combined with an easily controlled rig is perfect for sailors of a wide range of abilities.

And comes supplied with built in storage compartments in the cockpit and the transom areas, trapeze kit and optional outboard bracket.

The power source is a modern and easily handled rig and can even be reefed for less experienced crews or in high winds. The simple zip reefing main can be reduced or increased dependent on the conditions and crew on the day. The furling jib means you can transform the Omega to an exciting singlehander very simply. The gennaker system is supremely efficient and even young sailors can raise or lower the gennaker on a single line launch as smoothly as the professionals. And the trapeze is yet another fun option.

# Topaz Omega

TESTED

The notoriously tough and thorough testing team at Yachts and Yachting have been the first to get their hands on the Omega. They recorded a glowing report echoing the vociferous feedback of the first set of very happy Omega owners. Here are just some of Yachts & Yachting's observations. ## Design

### Space

The Topaz Omega is big, roomy and comfortable enough for all kinds of family sailing, which means it should be equally useful for sailing schools and holiday operators like SunSail.

"The cockpit seems vast, with enough room to sit inside or on benches."

### Control

"The Topaz Omega is easy to handle from trailer to water, particularly for older sailors who are attracted by the space and stability of the cockpit."

### Features - Beam

"The main beam is one of the clever things about the Omega. It puts rigidity and weight exactly where the designer wants it in the hull, while removing clutter from the cockpit."

### GNAV

Other neat items include a GNAV, a head friendly kicking strap, using the bolt rope system so the mainsail can be hoisted from one side...

### Safety

"More clever design features come into play. An optional triangular foam float that can be attached to the head of the sail provides enough flotation with the sealed mast to ensure to ensure you can walk on the rig - without the Omega going right over!"

### Gennaker

"The kite is launched out of its bag from the bow, with an easy-up, easy-down system."

### Reefing

"A neat, user friendly roll-and-zip reefing system reduces the size of the mainsail... you can make a few rolls on the water and carry on sailing with however much area feels right for the conditions."

### Outboard bracket

"Another simple solution we liked was the outboard bracket, which uses a second set of rudder pintles on one side of the transom with the option of an outboard storage locker inside the boat."

### Freeboard
